- ✚ Subtraction

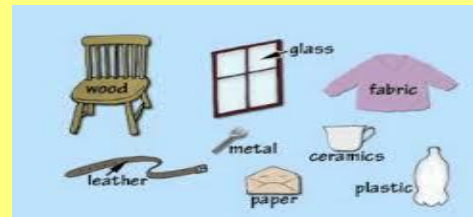
In History our topic is Old and New toys. We will be looking at our favourite toys and finding out all about toys in the past.

Helping at home:
