Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Parents and Carers,

In response to the Coronavirus outbreak across the world, school continues to review the advice from the Department for Education, Public Health England and the new daily updates from our Prime Minister; at this time, school is to remain **open**.

We will react to any guidance accordingly and update you in the form of a text or letter, with this in mind, [please ensure that the School Office has your most up to date contact details](#).

What are we doing to help?

In addition to the information shared last week, from today, we have implemented these new measures listed below:

- No assemblies will take place - these will be held in classes
- Educational trips will not be taking place until further notice – any payment paid can be either held on ParentPay until the trip is rearranged or a refund can be processed
- All sports tournaments have been cancelled
- No visitors will be coming into school, including meetings with external people
- Parent Afternoons in school, have been cancelled for this term
- Parent Evenings have been cancelled – teachers will complete a report card to update you on your child
- After School Clubs will continue to run as the children are already in school, with the exception of horse riding and trampolining, which have been cancelled

What can you do to help?

If a child has the following symptoms:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature,

The child should remain at home for at least 7 days. Children displaying these symptoms at school will be sent home.

The most important continued advice that individuals can do to protect themselves remains washing their hands more often, for at least 20 seconds, with soap and water. Making sure you cough or sneeze into a tissue, putting it in a bin and washing your hands.
