

# Year 5 Curriculum Overview



## Maths

For maths this term, we will be covering a number of topics. We will be re-visiting place value and will be developing our understanding of this topic. We will also be covering addition, subtraction, statistics and measurements this term.

A focus will also be made on arithmetic to ensure pupils are confident with their mental maths.

## English

This term for English we will be reading 'Floodland' and 'Skellig'.

There will be a number of opportunities for some excellent writing pieces where we will be building our own ideas and will be challenging our views. In class we will also be discussing and debating language in more detail.

## Art

Our first topic for art this term is 'The Seaside'. We will be looking at how we draw using a pen and colours. This term we will also be creating fish lanterns.

## Science

For science this term we will be covering separating mixtures.

We will be covering properties of materials, how to keep them cool, dissolving and irreversible changes.

## Geography

In geography this term we learning about Local Fieldwork.

We will be looking why geographers do field work and what enquires are being carried out. We will also be learning about fieldwork, maps and we will be creating our very own community map.

## RE

This term of RE we will be covering the 'Why do some people think God exist?'

We will be looking at how some people don't believe in God and how your upbringing can impact your religious belief.

## PE

With the Sport Coach, pupils will be covering hockey every Thursday.

As a class we will also be carrying out a number of Team Games every Tuesday.

## PSHE

Throughout this term, we will be studying the topic 'Being the Prime Minister' for our PSHE lessons.

We will be learning about what our country needs, questions for the Prime Minister and we will be covering the Black Life Matters movement.

## Computing

For computing this term, we will be looking at Internet Research and E-safety.

We will be looking at how we can create powerful passwords and how we can manage SPAM.

## French

This term we will be learning French and will be covering 'Getting to know you' and 'All about ourselves.'

We will be learning how to pronounce words in French and how to write them.
