Parking outside of school

We have received the following information from Salford City Council regarding car parking outside of schools.

- Salford City Council will begin a targeted crack down on illegal and dangerous parking near schools next week.
- Salford City Council isn't able to deploy enforcement officers to every area across the city where illegal parking is a problem so extra enforcement at the four worst hot spots will begin from Monday 21 September using new CCTV cameras.
- Those caught breaking the law will be sent a £70 penalty charge (£35 if paid within 14 days.)
- We need your help in reminding all drivers to park **legally, safely and considerately** for residents around schools.
