## Return to School Arrangements – September 2021

Dear parents,

I hope that everyone has had a relaxing and enjoyable summer holidays and, despite any restrictions that have been in place, managed to enjoy some quality family time.

I wanted to write to you ahead of our return to school on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September with information about how school will now operate, in ways to keep everyone safe and offer the best possible education to our children, as we aim to return to a level of normality following a disruptive year.

I have published a letter from the local authority on the school website, which summarises the main changes to the operation of schools for this term. Below is some school specific information to support parents on the first morning of school and beyond.

Start and Finish times	We will no longer have to stagger start and finish times. We will revert back to the school gates opening at 8:50am and registers being taken at 9:00am. We are however going to continue to use the 3 gates as detailed below.

	Gate 1 (corner gate)	Nursery, Reception, Year 2
	Gate 2 (main entrance)	Year 3 and Year 6
	Gate 3 (car park)	Year 1, Year 4, Year 5 and ASC provision
Parents coming into school grounds	We have missed seeing parents as much last year. From this week, we are asking that parents continue to leave their child at the school gate each morning as we have did last year. However, at the end of the school day parents will be able to collect their child from the classroom door. This will provide opportunity to speak to your child's teacher, should you need to discuss anything.	
School Uniform	We expect all children to be in full school uniform, as detailed on the school website, when we return in September. We do have some support available for uniform, including some good quality second hand uniform in school. Please contact the school office if you feel this would be beneficial to you.	
Lunches	Children will start to eat their lunch in the school hall and from October half-term, parents will be able to select choices on Cypad.	

We are all looking forward to welcoming the children back on Wednesday.
