Year 2 – Latest advice from Public Health

Dear Parents,

Due to the number of positive cases reaching 20% of the number of children in the class, Public Health have now advised that we close Year 2 for the next 48 hours to allow for a deep clean within the classroom to hopefully prevent any further spread of the virus. This means that Year 2 will re-open on Monday 29th November.

All children are now **strongly advised** to go for a PCR test. Please go to www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test to book a test. You will be asked to identify whether your child has COVID symptoms. If your child has no symptoms, you should select 'No' for this answer and proceed through the questions until you get to the question: "**Why are you asking for a test?**" You should select the box that says - **I've been in contact with a positive person – I found out in another way that I'm a contact** option. You can then proceed to book the test.

Please note that we will not be able to allow any child back into school on Monday 29th November without proof of a negative PCR test dated from today's date or after.

Without proof of a negative PCR test, children will need to self-isolate for 10 days from today, meaning that they cannot return to school until **Monday 6th December**.

Mrs. Woolley is currently organising remote learning for the next 2 days. Please ensure that school has your correct email address and that you check your emails for when the class will meet on Google Classrooms. We will be contacting all families throughout the day today by telephone to discuss this further and answer any questions.
